As the GIS Specialist, you would play an integral role in community-based research, training, mapping, and analyzing spatial information relating to wildlife, cultural land uses, and other activities on the land and water in the territory. Opportunities for field surveys, data collection and verification are also part of the diverse work setting. We offer a competitive salary for motivated and experienced candidates.

The ideal candidate will possess the following education, skills, and experience:

- bachelor's degree or higher education in GIS, with 3 years experience;
- training and experience using ESRI ArcGIS, Google Earth PRO, and QGIS
- general knowledge of the various industrial sectors in northeast B.C.;
- an understanding of modelling, spatial data analysis;
- excellent problem solving and communication skills
- ability to work independently;
- conducting traditional use studies and managing cultural information as well as a background working with Aboriginal people and an understanding of their rights would be an asset;
